

## Reserved Senior Painted Parking Space Application & Contract 2026-2027

Piper Seniors will have the opportunity to showcase their style and personality while supporting Project Grad by painting their own parking spot. For \$70 (\$50 for Project Grad & \$20 for the school's parking fee), we hope to involve all students. In an effort to allow this opportunity for students, and maintain Piper High School's atmosphere of professionalism and high standards, the following requirements and rules are set forth in this contract:

### DETAILS

- Personalized spots will be \$50 each. PayPal (QR below), cash and checks will be accepted. Make check payments to "Piper PG 27." Checks or cash must accompany the application, and we'll verify payment at application drop-off. Please note, the \$50 fee **does not include** the \$20 school parking fee. That \$20 fee will need to be paid via check separately and handed in with this application.
- Bring your completed forms to the current senior parking spot location at Piper High School on Wednesday, July 22<sup>nd</sup> between 7:00 pm – 8:00 pm. Students will pick their spots on the map when they turn in their payment and sketch. Students & parents will be required to sign a waiver stating that they have read this application.
- Sketches will be approved by the PHS principal. Notification of required changes will be done by email. Look for your email by Thursday, July 30<sup>th</sup>. If you do not receive an email, your design is approved.

Painting Dates: Saturday and Sunday, August 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> from 7am to 7pm. The backup date is August 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup>. Email questions to: 2027piperpg@gmail.com

### GUIDELINES:

We encourage students to express themselves through positive artwork. Your spot should be fun and reflect who you are! Think of your parking spot as a t-shirt that you wear to school. Consider dress code guidelines and other handbook policies when designing your spot. Keep it classy! School-spirit designs are highly encouraged. You can use your name, sports, jersey number, musical instrument, favorite college or hobbies. Any artwork depicting items, symbols, or language that are deemed inappropriate or offensive will not be allowed. Once your artwork has been approved, that is what has to be painted on your spot. Any deviation, including color, from that design will result in your artwork being painted over and NO refund will be given.

### PAINTING REQUIREMENTS:

- Paint must be WATER-BASED EXTERIOR LATEX paint
- Aerosol cans, reflective paint, fluorescent paint, or oil-based paints are strictly prohibited
- NO air or airless paint sprayers are permitted
- There must be a 3" gap between paint and white parking space lines. Keep the design within the borders

### WHAT TO BRING TO PAINT DAY SUGGESTIONS

- Chalk to outline your design
- Killz or another primer to paint over the previous year's design
- Paint and paint brushes or rollers
- Masking tape or painters tape for the 3" border inside the parking lines
- Broom to sweep the parking space
- Rags, water...paper or tarp to lay supplies on
- Drinking water – it gets hot
- Pop-up/canopy tent and chairs

- Knee pad and/or something to sit on while painting (piece of old carpet/rug)

**PAINT DAY PROCEDURES**

- Check in at the Project Grad table in the SENIOR parking lot for paint approval, designated space assignment to receive your approved design back. You must follow the design exactly, no changes to the design are allowed
- Sweep off/prepare your spot to have a clean surface. Lay paper or tarp down for supplies so paint does not get anywhere else other than your parking spot. You must have a 3” unpainted border along the parking space lines
- Use painters tape or sidewalk chalk to measure and create the required 3” border

Use the space below to sketch your design for approval. Design must be completed in COLOR and show EXACTLY what will be painted on your parking spot. Again, any deviation from your design after approval will result in your spot being painted over with NO refund given. The painted area must have a 3” border along the parking space lines. You will get an email stating if your drawing needs changed.

If you do not have a printer, draw on an 8 x 10 plain sheet of paper and we will attach it to your form. We will have forms available for you to fill out on drop off night.
